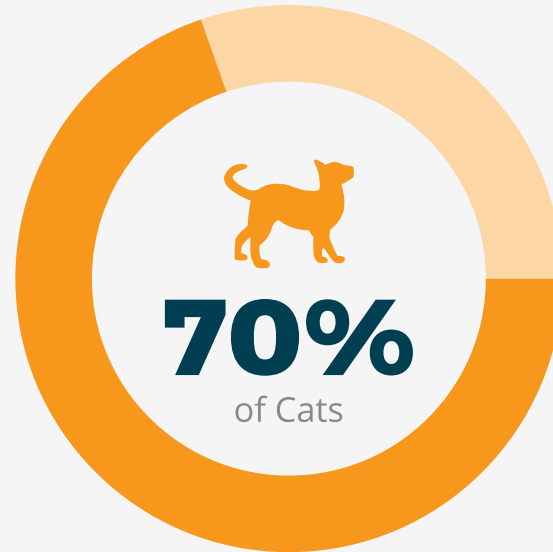
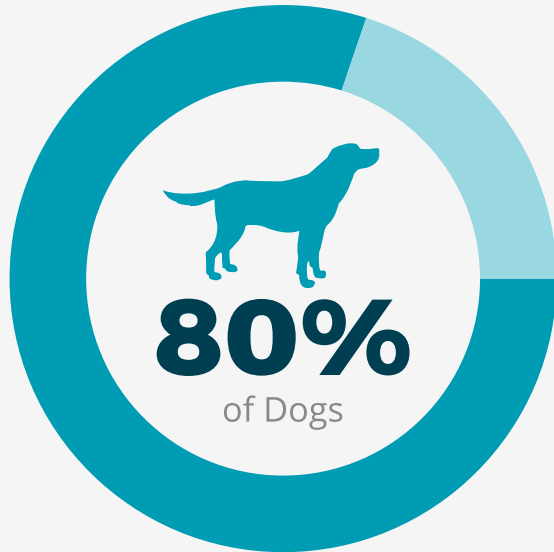
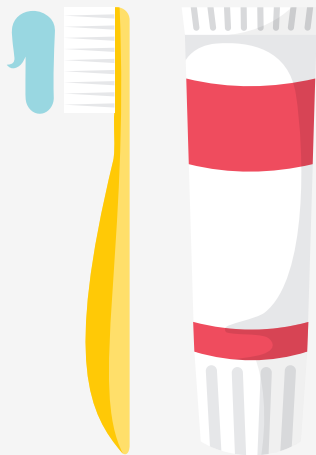


FRESH FACTS ON PET DENTAL HEALTH

- ✓ Bad breath or excessive drooling.
- ✓ Loss of appetite or weight loss.
- ✓ Tartar at the gum line.
- ✓ Bleeding or red gums.
- ✓ Swelling of the face and mouth.
